FOOTBALL TIDBITS

In LSU's 45-38 win over Texas, Joe Burrow became the first LSU quarterback to throw for 400 passing yards against an AP-ranked opponent since Rohan Davey in the 2002 Sugar Bowl against Illinois. He is also just the third LSU player to throw for 400 passing yards in a game.

Texas QB, Sam Ehlinger is the first QB with 400 pass yards in a game against LSU since Geno Smith had 463 pass yards vs the Tigers in 2011. Ehlinger is also the first Texas QB with at least 7 passing TD's through the first 2 team games of a season since Colt McCoy in 2008.

With its 28-25 loss to North Carolina, Miami (FL) has started the season 0-2 for the first time since 1978. The Hurricanes 45 points scored over their first two games is the worst since 2007.

After a home loss to San Diego State, UCLA has started 0-2 in consecutive seasons for the first time since 1942 & 1943. San Diego State got its first win over UCLA in program history.

When Clemson led Texas A&M 17-3 at halftime it was the 18th time that Clemson has outscored its opponent by 14+ points in a half since 2016, which is the most in the FBS. It's also the first time that Texas A&M had been held to 3 or fewer points in a half since last season against Clemson.

Justin Fields now has 9 total touchdowns through 2 games with Ohio State. He's tied with Dwayne Haskins (2018) and J.T. Barrett (2016) for the most total touchdowns by an Ohio State QB in the school's first 2 games over the last 15 seasons.

Under head coach Jim Harbaugh, Michigan is now 7-8 when trailing at halftime. They trailed Army 14-7 at the half in a game they eventually won in double overtime. The Wolverines lost 3 fumbles in the 1st half. Michigan lost 3 fumbles all last season.

Wake Forest has now scored at least 35 points in each of its first 2 games for the first time since 2010. Jamie Newman is the first ACC quarterback with at least 300 passing yards and 3 pass TD in each of his team's first two games of a season since Philip Rivers of North Carolina State in 2003.

Virginia's 52 points against William & Mary are the most it's scored since 2004 (56 vs North Carolina). Bryce Perkins had his 5th career game with 2 Pass TD and 1 Rush TD, the most by an ACC player since the start of last season.

South Florida is the second FBS team since classification began in 1937 to lose 8+ straight games immediately following a winning streak of at least 8. Ball State won 12 and then lost 9 in 2008 & 2009.

UPDATED NON-CONFERENCE RECORDS

Below, we list the updated non-conference records through the first two weeks of the college football season. An interesting fact is that the Southeastern Conference has lost 7 non-conference games thus far during the 2019 season. The SEC went the entire 2018 regular season losing just 6 non-conference games.

The "Cy-Hawk" trophy game between Iowa (2-0) & Iowa State (1-0) is one of the more underrated rivalry games in college football. This year the game will be played at Jack Trice Stadium on the campus of Iowa State. The game will be televised nationally on FS1 at 4:00 PM EDT.

Iowa State has had an extra week to prepare for this game after an open date last week. The Cyclones sit at 1-0 after 29-26 overtime victory over Northern Iowa. On the other hand, Iowa is 2-0 with convincing wins over Miami (OH) & Rutgers.

Iowa leads the all-time series 44-22 .667 and Iowa leads 28-13 .683 since the series was resumed in 1977. At Ames, Iowa leads 19-8 .704. Iowa has won the last 4 games. The largest all-time Iowa win was 57-3 in 1985. The largest Iowa State win was 31-0 in 1978. The highest scoring games was a 44-41 (3OT) Iowa State win in 2011 and also a 44-41 (1OT) Iowa win in 2017.

As good as Iowa has looked so far in 2019, we just like the fact that Iowa State is the home teams. We're taking the Cyclones to come away with a 30-24 victory
