FOOTBALL TIDBITS

Justin Herbert matched Marcus Mariota's Oregon school record for most 5 Pass TD games in a career with his fourth such game vs Montana this past Saturday.

Oklahoma secured its 21st consecutive win in a true road game at UCLA, tying Alabama's streak from 1970-75 for the 2nd-longest streak in the AP Poll Era (since 1936). The Sooners' next road game is Oct. 5 at Kansas.

- 1953-1958: Oklahoma25
- 2014-2019: Oklahoma21
- 1970-1975: Alabama21

To be fair this list is deceiving. Oklahoma's toughest game traditionally is against Texas in Dallas against whom they lost to in 2018 and Alabama, typically, played their toughest opponents at Legion Field in Birmingham back in the '70's and they lost several of those as well, so this stat is tainted.

Clemson has won 18 straight games, now the 2nd-longest streak in ACC history. The Tigers only trail Florida State, who won 29 consecutive games from 2012-2014. Clemson has won those 18 in a row by an average of 30.8 PPG.

This past Saturday, Jalen Hurts became the first Big 12 QB with 100+ rushing yards in a first quarter since Vince Young in Week 9 of 2005. Hurts rushed for 99 yards on Oklahoma's opening drive vs UCLA, the most rushing yards by any player on an opening drive of a game over the last 15 seasons.

Tua Tagovailoa passed for 444 yards against South Carolina, the 3rd-most in a single game in Alabama history. He also became the first Bama player to record 400 passing yards with 5 passing TD's in the same game. Tua Tagovailoa has recorded his 8th career game with at least 4 Passing TD's, passing AJ McCarron for the most in Alabama history. Tua also has the most such games by any FBS player since the start of last season.

Georgia Tech's 27-24 loss to The Citadel is just their 2nd loss to a non-FBS opponent since the FBS/FCS split in 1978. The Yellow Jackets only previous defeat came vs Furman on September 17, 1983. Georgia Tech had been 33-1-1 vs non-FBS schools since 1978.

Justin Fields is just the 3rd Ohio State player with 4 total touchdowns in at least 3 straight games over the last 20 years. He joins J.T. Barrett and Dwayne Haskins. J.K. Dobbins' 175 rushing yards at the half vs Indiana is the most rushing yards in a half by an Ohio State player since Ezekiel Elliott in 2015 (also against Indiana).

Maryland scored a combined 98 points in the first half in its first 2 games this season. The Terrapins scored just 2 points in the first half in their upset loss against Temple.

Jake Fromm is the 2nd Georgia QB over the last 15 years with 250 passing yards and 3 passing touchdowns in a single half. He joins Matthew Stafford who did it vs Georgia Tech in 2008.

Last Saturday was the 100th meeting between Pitt and Penn State. The Nittany Lions have now won 17 straight non-conference home games, the longest active streak in the Big Ten. Pitt's last win over a ranked Big Ten team came all the way back in 1988 vs Ohio State.

Houston QB D'Eriq King threw for a TD and rushed for a TD vs Washington State. It was his 14th consecutive game with both a Rushing TD and a Passing TD, tying the FBS record previously set by Tim Tebow.

The Notre Dame Fighting Irish (2-0) travel to Sanford Stadium to take on the Georgia Bulldogs (3-0) in a much anticipated game that will be nationally televised in Prime Time on CBS at 8:00 PM EDT.

Having QB, Jake Fromm, RB D'Andre Swift, WR Riley Ridley and an experienced offense line gives the Bulldogs a huge advantage vs just about any opponent on their schedule. Defensively Georgia is solid at most positions. They pressure the opposing QB into making throws that are less than ideal, and that's when the speedy Georgia secondary takes advantage.

Notre Dame QB Ian Book is very elusive, which can cause problems, but he would rather buy time scrambling around to find an open receiver than to tuck it and run. TE Cole Kmet could be very important in this game if Notre Dame wants to pull off the upset. The Irish defense is solid but not dominant. They can't miss open tackles in this game like they've been done in other big games in the recent past.

Georgia leads the all-time series vs Notre Dame 2-0. Georgia won the 1980 National Championship when the #1 Bulldogs beat #7 Notre Dame 17-10 in the Sugar Bowl and then two years ago when #15 Georgia beat #24 Notre Dame 20-19 in South Bend.

We like Georgia to come away with the win by the score of 35-28.
