# FOOTBALL TIDBITS

The entirety of SMU's 21-point comeback happened in the 4th quarter. Entering last Saturday, over the past 15 seasons, FBS teams trailing by 21+ entering the 4th quarter posted a record of 9 wins and 3,000 losses. The last such win prior to SMU was Oregon State's 41-34 win over Colorado last season.

After 3 TD's on Saturday vs Michigan State, Ohio State's Justin Fields is responsible for 26 touchdowns this season, tied for the most by a Big Ten player through 6 games over the last 15 seasons. Fields is the only Big Ten player over the last 20 seasons with a pass and rush TD in 6 straight games.

After gaining just 16 yards of total offense in the 1st quarter vs Michigan State, Ohio State rebounded in a big way with 296 yards of total offense in the 2nd quarter. That's their 2nd-most total yards in any quarter in the past 15 seasons.

Snoop Conner's 84-yd rushing TD was the longest run by an Ole Miss player since Jaylen Walton vs Mississippi State in 2014 (91 yards). Ole Miss had multiple 75-yard rushing TD's in the same game for the first time in school history.

Florida defeated Auburn 24-13 to win their 10th straight game, the longest active winning streak in the SEC. It is also the longest win streak for Florida since winning 22 straight games over the 2008 and 2009 seasons.

Sam Ehlinger's 2nd passing TD vs West Virginia was the 53rd of his career, tying James Brown for 4th-most in Texas football history. It was also Ehlinger's 12th game with a passing and rushing TD. That is the 3rd-most among Texas players over the last 20 seasons, trailing only Colt McCoy & Vince Young.

Ian Book is the 1st player in Notre Dame football history with 5 Passing TD's in a single half. Book is also just the 4th QB in Notre Dame history with multiple 5 Passing TD games in his career. Only Brady Quinn had more (3). The school record for Passing TD's in a single game is 6 by Brady Quinn.

Penn State has outscored their opponents 69-0 in the 1st quarter this season. Penn State has also outscored its opponents by 198 points this season. That is the most by a Penn State team through its first 5 games in the AP Poll Era (since 1936).

Prior to beating Iowa 10-3, the last time Michigan won a conference game at Michigan Stadium when scoring 10 points or fewer was November 11, 1995 when Michigan beat Purdue 5-0.

With its 48-0 win over Kent State, Wisconsin recorded its 3rd shutout this season. That is the Badgers' most shutouts in a single season since recording 3 in 1937.

Joe Burrow became the 6th QB in LSU history to throw 20 passing touchdowns in a season and he's accomplished it in just 5 games thus far. The school single-season record is 28 by JaMarcus Russell in 2006.

Wisconsin's Jonathan Taylor is the only FBS player to have at least 10 rushing touchdowns in each of the last 3 seasons. Taylor is the first Big Ten RB to rush for 10 touchdowns in 3 straight seasons since Montee Ball (2010-2012).

Cincinnati had lost 13 straight games against AP-ranked opponents before last Friday night's 27-24 win over #18 UCF. Their last win came at #14 Pitt in 2009 when the Bearcats were ranked #5. UCF had scored at least 30 points in 31 straight games, the longest streak among any major college team in the poll era (since 1936). That streak is now over.

UCF's loss at Cincinnati also snapped its conference win streak (not including conference title games) at 17, which was the longest in the FBS. The new active leader is Clemson with 14 straight wins.

After coming off a big win over Auburn last Saturday, the Florida Gators (6-0) will travel to Baton Rouge to take on the LSU Tigers (5-0). This battle will kickoff at 8:00 PM EDT and will be televised on ESPN.

Florida's defense was very impressive vs Auburn last week and we believe that the Gators must once again play up to that level to win this game. QB Kyle Trask has done everything asked of him. He's played as well as any Gator fan could have wanted. Another key player for the Gators is RB Lamical Perine. He looked good vs Auburn, rushing for 130 yards with a touchdown. Going back to last year, Florida has now won 10 consecutive games.

Quarterback, Joe Burrow continues to light up the scoreboard but now the competition starts to get better and better so don't expect LSU to look as good as they have. As much publicity as Burrow has received, it's probably going to be running backs Clyde Edwards-Helaire & Tyrion Davis-Price who will determine the success that LSU will have on offense.

Florida leads the all-time series vs LSU 33-29-3. In Baton Rouge, Florida leads 17-16-0. Florida beat LSU last year 27-19. We believe that this game is very evenly matched but we're going to go with the home team Tigers to come away with the victory, 30-27.
