# FOOTBALL TIDBITS

With their 56-21 win over Rutgers this past Saturday, the 2019 Ohio State Buckeyes tied the 1971 Nebraska Cornhuskers with 10 consecutive wins of 24 or more points in one season. The 1973 Ohio State Buckeyes, 2012 Boise State Broncos and 2013 Florida State Seminoles won 9 consecutive games by 24 or more points. Below we compare the 1971 Nebraska Cornhuskers and the 2019 Ohio State Buckeyes.

MOV Denotes "Margin of Victory"

In the College Football Playoff Era (since 2014), teams had been a combined 0-162 against a CFP-ranked team in the regular-season when trailing by at least 25 points until Oklahoma's amazing comeback vs Baylor. The Sooners overcame a 28-3 deficit to beat the Bears 34-31.

Ole Miss QB, John Rhys Plumlee became the 5th SEC quarterback over the last 20 seasons with 4 rushing touchdowns (vs LSU this past Saturday), joining Nick Fitzgerald (Mississippi State) who did it twice, Cam Newton (Auburn), Tim Tebow (Florida) and Jesse Palmer (Florida).

Georgia clinched the SEC East for the 3rd consecutive year, the longest streak by an SEC East team since Florida represented the division in the first 5 SEC title games.

Wisconsin RB Jonathan Taylor became the first major college football player in the past 25 seasons with three 200-yard rushing games against a single opponent. Here are his stats vs Nebraska for the past three seasons: 204 yards vs Nebraska in 2019, 221 yards vs Nebraska in 2018, and 249 yards vs Nebraska in 2017.

Clemson has scored 50+ points in 4 straight games, tying 2016 Louisville for the longest streak in ACC history.

Ian Book had his 3rd game with 5 passing TD's this season, the most in a season in Notre Dame history. It also tied Brady Quinn for the most career games with 5 pass TD.

Ohio State RB, JK Dobbins has multiple scrimmage touchdowns in 4 straight games, the longest streak by an Ohio State player since Ezekiel Elliott in 2014.

Northwestern defeated UMass by 39 points, by a score of 45-6. Northwestern's 45 points are more than they had scored in their previous 5 games combined.

The 16-point halftime deficit for Central Michigan at Ball State was the team's largest overcome in a road win since Oct. 20, 1979 (down 17, also at Ball State).

The 34-point margin of victory by Michigan (44-10) was its largest in a game it trailed at the end of the 1st quarter since November 18, 1989 (49-15 at Minnesota).

Including this past weekend's 17-7 victory, San Diego State has 4 wins over the last 2 seasons in which they've scored fewer than 20 points, tying TCU for the most in the Football Bowl Subdivision.

Oklahoma's 21-point halftime deficit overcome to win is the largest to defeat an FBS team that entered the game 9-0 or better since the NCAA classification began in 1937. The previous record was 17 points by Southern California against 9-0 ND in 1964 and Nevada against 10-0 Boise State in 2010.

Penn State (9-1) will go to Ohio Stadium to take on Ohio State (10-0) in a huge game in the Big Ten. The winner has the inside track to the Big Ten Championship Game. This game will kickoff at 12:00 Noon and it will be televised nationally on FOX.

James Franklin's Penn State Nittany Lions are having a really good season and it can become a great season if they win on Saturday. QB Sean Clifford must play his best game of the season for Penn State to have a chance to win and the PSU defense has to put pressure on Justin Fields all day long.

QB Justin Fields and RB JK Dobbins will head up the high octane Ohio State offense. The Buckeyes are very balanced both passing and running the ball which makes defending them so difficult. Chase Young leads a stingy Ohio State defense and will be important that Penn State double teams him as much as possible.

This is one of the greatest rivalries in the Big Ten Conference. Ohio State leads the all-time series 20-14. In Columbus, Ohio State leads 12-7. The last two years Ohio State has come away with 1 point wins (39-38 in 2017 and 27-26 in 2018). This Ohio State team is one of the better OSU teams in recent memory and with the game being played at the Horseshoe, we like the Buckeyes to come away with the victory 33-24.
