FOOTBALL TIDBITS

Oklahoma QB Jalen Hurts became the 3rd player in major college football history with 3,000 passing yards and 1,000 rushing yards in the first 11 games of a season, joining Lamar Jackson & Johnny Manziel. Jackson (2016) and Manziel (2012) would go on to win the Heisman Trophy during those seasons.

Wisconsin RB Jonathan Taylor had his 12th career game with at least 200 rushing yards, breaking a tie with Ron Dayne, Ricky Williams, and Marcus Allen for the most such games in FBS history.

Shea Patterson is the 4th player in Michigan history with 20 passing TDs in multiple seasons, joining Chad Henne, John Navarre and Elvis Grbac. Patterson is also the 2nd player in Michigan history with 5 passing TDs in a game (Jake Rudock had 6 also against Indiana in 2015).

Ohio State has clinched the Big Ten East Division for the 3rd consecutive season. 2019 is their 8th consecutive season with at least 11 wins. Tying Alabama's mark for most in the AP Poll era (since 1936).

Chase Young now holds the single-season record for most sacks in Ohio State history with 14.5. He passes Vernon Gholston who recorded 14 in 2007

Minnesota QB Tanner Morgan had 3 passing TD's vs Purdue and currently has 25 on the season. He passes Adam Weber (2007) for most single-season passing touchdowns in school history.

Very few people would have predicted that the game between Minnesota (10-1) and Wisconsin (9-2) would be the Game-of-the-Week over Ohio State-Michigan or Alabama-Auburn when the season began but here we are. This game at TCF Bank Stadium in Minneapolis will kickoff at 3:30 PM EST and will be televised nationally on ABC.

P.J. Fleck has done a lot of good things since he arrived in Minneapolis. Getting QB Tanner Morgan has to rank high on that list. Morgan has shown that he is ready for the big stage. He's completing 70% of his passes and has done a great job of taking care of the ball. His favorite target is WR Rashod Bateman. RB Rodney Smith is a 1,000 yard rusher so they are very balanced on offense.

Wisconsin goes as RB Jonathan Taylor goes. Even with a target on his back all season, Taylor has had another outstanding season. QB Jack Coan has had a great year too. If the Badgers can get 125 yards rushing from Taylor and 200 yards passing from Coan, they will be very difficult to beat on Saturday.

The all-time series between Minnesota and Wisconsin is tied 60-60-8. In games played in Madison Wisconsin leads 34-23-6. In Minneapolis the Golden Gophers leads 37-26-2. Minnesota won in Madison last year 37-15. Prior to that win in 2018, Wisconsin had won 14 straight vs Minnesota. In fact Wisconsin has won 21 of the last 24 games vs Minnesota from 1995-2018. We're going to take the road team. Wisconsin 27, Minnesota 24.
